1. Introduction

1.1 General

This information notice explains how data generated by, or collected through, the ARX products listed in section 2 (the "**Products**") is accessed, used, and shared (including to provide the ARX software (the "**Service**")) and how the data is otherwise processed, in line with the requirements under Article 3 of the EU Data Act.

1.2 Product and service description

ARX is an electronic access control (EAC) system for the commercial market, managing access control and alarm systems in a common system and hardware, for small/medium up to large organizations/companies that are spread geographically and extend across national borders. Data is generated as users interact with the system as described below. The data generated is stored either on the products or on an on-premise server maintained by the system owner/customer.

1.3 Data holders

The following parties receive data from the Product and/or the Service and may use the data for their own purposes ('data holders'):

The system owner/customer

The product can integrate/work with other products provided by ASSA ABLOY. The product can be integrated with:

- CLIQ Web Manager, Electronic key administration from ARX
- Mobile Key using HID Origo Portal

An API is also maintained allowing third parties to integrate their products or services, such as Interbook, Kone elevator and OPC.

Depending on the nature of the integration, an ASSA ABLOY company or third party may also be a data holder, in addition to the system owner/customer.

As data generated by the Service is hosted on-premises by the system owner/customer, they are able to access the data generated directly, as described above, and share it with a third party at their discretion.

6. Right to lodge a complaint

7. Trade secrets

In some cases, data from the connected products or related services may include trade secrets that we or our partners own.
