

Turn your smartphone into your key. The intuitive Yale Home app lets you manage the access of your home remotely.*

*When used in conjunction with a Yale Connect Wi-Fi Bridge





DOWNLOAD YALE HOME APP

 The app requires a minimum operating system of iOS 11 Plus for iPhone, and 8 Plus for Android based phones. Bluetooth 4.0.

iOS SYSTEM: Once you have the app you can press and hold on the app to share the app to other iphone users.

IMPORTANT!

- 1. Always set up a **master code** at the face of the lock before pairing with the app
- 2. When downloading the app there is a **dual authentication** process required and as part of this you will be sent a text message with a code in it and then you will be sent an email with code in it
- 3. Always make sure that you set up your phone with the lock and don't try to install and set up the Connect Wi-Fi Bridge first **THIS WON'T WORK**





ANDROID SYSTEM: For an Android based phone you will need to search for the app in the Google app store, you can save a link to this store in your favourites.

IMPORTANT!

- 1. Always set up a **master code** at the face of the lock before setting up the app
- 2. With Android phone this text message number will **auto populate** it's easy to miss this step and you will be trying to put the text number where the email number should go. Read carefully and take your time! (When downloading the app there is a dual authentication process required and as part of this you will be sent a text message with a code in it and then you will be sent an email with code in it.)
- 3. Always make sure that you set up your phone with the lock and don't try to install and set up the Connect Wi-Fi Bridge first **THIS WON'T WORK**

SET UP YALE HOME MODULE

- Insert Network Module First
- Wi-Fi bridge cannot be registered until the module registration is complete.






IMPORTANT!

 Always remove at least one battery before inserting the module* (This step allows the lock to recognise the Network Module and begin the pairing)





• Input your master code at the face of the lock. Using this master code should allow you to bring up the master menu and the screen will display the numbers 1 and 7. Once in this screen you can register the module by pressing the (7) and then the # symbol. The light on the front of the lock will flash and play a 3 key notes sound to confirm that your Accesss Module is registered to your lock.

SET UP YALE HOME MODULE



You will open the app to register after the module has been inserted and paired via the keypad on the lock.

QUICK MENU ICON

	Touch the keypad with palm to begin and end actions.	MPIN	Enter Master Code(4~10digits).
1 ~0	Click the indicated number.	UPIN	Enter User Code(4~10digits).
*	Press [*] button on the keypad.	VPIN	Enter Visitor Code(Only 4digits).
#	Press [#] button on the keypad.	OPIN	Enter Onetime Code (Only 4digits).
	Press ①(Registration)button inside of the battery cover.	CARD	Enter User Card Key. (Up to 40ea)
	Repeat operation using settings indicated.	UN	User Slot Number should be 2 digits.

TROUBLE SHOOTING



FIRMWIRE UPDATE

If the firmware update stalls at 100%, return to your homescreen (but leave the app running in the background), then reopen the app.

INSTALL CONNECT WI-FI BRIDGE

• Install the Connect Wi-Fi Bridge if you wish to extend the range from Bluetooth to remote access. Please note that before you set it up, make sure your phone is **connected to the WiFi using 2.4GHZ*.**


Note: Only 2.4GHZ will work with Yale Home





The app will prompt you to set up a 'Wi-Fi bridge' once you have registered the module.

Alternatively



Open the app and go to the tab at the top left of the home page, once in here press on "SET UP A DEVICE"



Scan the QR code
(or enter the code as circled),
then plug the bridge
into a power socket
within BLE range of
the lock. Follow as
instructed by the Yale
Home app.

IMPORTANT!

- You won't be able to make the connection if you are using **5GHZ**, but you can change back to 5Ghz once the bridge has been connected.
- The "signal appears to be weak" doesn't affect the bridge's performance, continue past this point until the set up is finished.
