Keying Options



ASSA ABLOY

ASSA ABLOY supplies "keyed to differ" cylinders with all locks unless special keying systems are requested. Selected ASSA ABLOY lock cylinders can be keyed alike to the same key, keyed to differ, construction keyed, master keyed or grand master keyed. These keying concepts are explained below.


Keyed to Differ (KD)

The key will only operate that particular cylinder. Used in standalone installations - usually supplied to the "do-it-yourself" market.



Master Key (MK)


Keyed Alike (KA)



A number of cylinders in a group can be operated by one "master key" whilst at the same time can also be operated by individual keys. The master keying system is useful in applications such as motels, hotels, and office blocks amongst others.


MASTER KEY

Construction Key (CK)
A construction keyed cylinder provides builders and contractors with access to a building during its construction stage via a "construction key". This system works in conjunction with a "servant key" (i.e. the owner's key). Once the servant key is used in the lock, the construction key can no longer operate the cylinder. The servant key is therefore used at the completion of the job disenabling access of construction key holders (builders/contractors) to the building without the need to



Master Key (MK)

Grand Master Key (GMK) An extension of a master key system, where a grand master key will operate a number of master key systems. For use in multilevel buildings that have a master key system for each floor or department.



Additional Keys

- Keyed to Diner 2 keys per lock
 Keyed Alike:

 within the same product group 2 keys per lock
 across a range of products minimum 4 keys per houselot

 Construction Key minimum 4 servant keys per houselot
 Master Key 2 servant keys per KD lock and KA group with 2 GMK and MK for the entire system
